# TIRE PRICING & A TIRE RULE CHANGE

All tire prices include mounting and tax. There is a \$5 per tire charge for credit card sales.

F-70s & F-60s (Late Model & Limited Late Model) 800 Series (Street Stock) 790s (FWD—FWD may also run DOT 200 treadwear or higher) \$155 per tire; \$620 per set. \$150 per tire; \$600 per set. \$140 per tire; \$560 per set.

NEW. Late Model and Limited Late Model classes can run F-60s on the LEFT SIDE ONLY.

## WELCOME STEAK 'N SHAKE AS THE NEW LATE MODEL SPONSOR



Steak 'n Shake (West Main) offered up a few Wild Card Nights in 2024 and this year comes on board as the Late Model Sponsor. Steak 'n Shake West Main is open 24 hours and has half-price Happy Hour from 2:00 – 4:00 PM weekdays for shakes and drinks!

### **FWD POINTS & SEASON CHAMPIONS**

The new combined Front Wheel Drive class will be familiar in many ways. All cars will use group qualifying. Based on qualifying speed, cars will be assigned to a feature. The top 20 cars will race in the 'A' feature, the next 20 to the 'B' and the remaining cars will race in the 'C' feature (a 'D' feature will be added when necessary). We're trying to come up with some more creative names than A-B-C. Stay tuned!! Because features are based on qualifying times, it is likely that there will be a mix of 790s and DOT tires in the 'A' and likely 'B' features.

Points will start at 100 for the 'A' feature winner, like always. The 'B' feature winner will earn points corresponding to 21<sup>st</sup> place. Points will decrease by 2 points (100-98-96-94-92-90, etc.) through 20, then points decrease by 1 point (20-19-18-17-16-15), with 15 points being the fewest points a driver earns (unless disqualified).

Note: When a driver qualifies for the 'A' feature at any three (3) FWD point races, that driver will be locked into earning points toward the 'A' Season Championship, regardless of whether s/he qualifies slower on other nights and runs in the 'B' feature. The breakout rules will still apply: always try to qualify at your car's top speed. A disqualification for a breakout time will impact a driver's point standings and payout more than sandbagging to try to game the system.

On Season Championship Night we will recognize 3 champions for the FWD class: An 'A', 'B' and 'C' level winner. We'll publish the rules on how the 'B' and 'C' champions will be determined before the start of the season; with some drivers being locked into the 'A' points race, it's a bit more complicated than setting the 21st place as the 'B' season champion and 41st for the 'C'.


### **INVERSIONS**

For the weekly race nights, we are retiring the pink dice! Instead there will be a spinning wheel that will have a 16-14-12-10 on each side of the wheel. And just like Wheel of Fortune, there will be a smaller sliver on the wheel that will represent NO inversion and another that represents a FULL inversion.




# **TOP TEN (2024) STREET STOCK**
