



Kalamazoo Speedway may have taken a forced COVID sabbatical for the 2020 season but the old girl is back to take her place as the area leader in short track racing. We're proud to announce an ambitious 2021 schedule. We'll still be concentrating on our five weekly classes but you'll notice we've added a lot of new excitement for 2021. Let's go racing!

The official start of the 2021 season kicks off on April 30 with the \$5,000 to win **Intimidator 100** for the Outlaw Super Late Models. All five weekly classes will be running at the season opener. However, before the official start of the season, we'll be warming up the track with the **Covid Crusher** on April 17. This is an open event for the Street Stock (\$1,500 to win) and Zoo Stock (paying \$750 to win).

May 8 marks Kalamazoo Speedway's very first springtime **Night of Destruction** featuring the best stunts and crash events found anywhere. Then on May 15, the hottest Modifieds in the Midwest make their return to Kalamazoo Speedway running their \$5,000 to win **100 lap Modified Nationals**. The Street Stock will duke it out for \$1,000 to win and the Zoo Stock will wrestle for the \$500 top prize.

For the first time in Kalamazoo Speedway's 71 year history, the Speedway will host two Klash events for the Outlaw Super Late Models. Mark your calendars for the June 11 running of the \$6,000 to win **Covid Klash XXVIII!** Then on August 18 we'll be running the \$10,000 to win **Kalamazoo Klash XXIX.**

Joining the Outlaw Super Late Models at the COVID Klash on June 11, the Street Stocks will be on tap with their own star-studded event, the \$2,500 to win **Raber's Rumble**. Our own Template Late Models will be chasing \$5,000 at the August 18 Kalamazoo Klash XXIX.

For the Open Wheel fans, June 18 and 19 marks **Open Wheel Madness** that will feature the Winged Super Modifieds and Winged Super Sprints. Stay tuned for dates on two additional open wheel events in 2021.

For **Night of Destruction** fans, you won't find any more chaos, mayhem and destruction anywhere than at the three events held at Kalamazoo Speedway in 2021: May 8, June 26 and September 18. These three nights will reshape the Night of Destruction events in the Midwest.

And lastly, you'll notice that **Super Shoe XXXIV** got bumped up a week. Four of the last five Super Shoe events had terrible weather; it's time to roll the dice and try another weekend. Make your plans now for September 24-26.

We may have been shuttered in 2020 by circumstances outside of our control, but we will, again, be leading the pack in 2021 with huge shows, great car counts and some of the best side by side racing action found anywhere. Stay tuned for more events being rolled out as the rest of the 2021 Kalamazoo Speedway schedule comes together.
