MAY 17: RACING RECAP.



Jerry Pierman drove to the top of the leaderboard in qualifying with a time of 13.900 (97.122 MPH) for the AFC Metal Supply Models Isaac Ross

(skipped Victory Lane) and Rick Senneker (left) won the 8-lap heat races.





Fifteen cars competed in the 35-lap feature. Fresh off his heat win, Rick Senneker assumed the early lead. Pack racing behind him allowed him to temporarily pull away from the rest of the field. With 10 laps in, Isaac Ross was in second place with Jared Blanchard, Bill Tomlinson and Jerry Pierman behind him. Fifteen laps into the race, Ross got around Senneker as did Blanchard; Billy Shannon cracked the top five. Pierman got around Blanchard with 13 to go and Eric McGlothlen made it into 5th place. That order held through the rest of the race. Isaac Ross took the checked with Jerry Pierman in the runner-up position, followed by Jared Blanchard (top three photo to left), Billy Shannon and Eric McGlothlen. Taylor Sexton led off the second half of the order followed by Kenny Head, Bill Tomlinson, Rick Senneker and Chris Garrett (all on the lead lap). Jerry Pierman extended his one point lead of last week to nine (600) followed by Billy Shannon (591) and Jared Blanchard (551).

The Honor Credit Union Limited Late Model class continues to

grow. Jeff Ganus captured fast time 13.371 (100.965 MPH). Brock Ganus (skipping Victory Lane) won one of the 8-lap heats and Bob Bliss (below) won the other.





Bob Bliss took the lead for the

20-lap feature and held it for a few laps before Josh Trammell drove his way to the front. The 88 of Michael "Bubba" Brooks bested Trammell with 10 laps remaining. Bryce Bozell got around Brooks with Jeff Ganus right on his tail. Ganus rounded Bozell while Brock Ganus was pushing Trammell to the fourth position. In a lively race, it was Jeff Ganus with the win and young Bryce Bozell in the runner-up position. Brock Ganus was third followed by Michael Brooks and Cody Hawn wrapping up the top five. Leading off the second

half of the order was Josh Trammell, Bob Bliss, Louis Miller (all on the lead lap) followed by Mason May (-1) and Terry

Kline (-2). (Kline also pilots the #27 front wheel drive car). There's a new point leader this week, Bryce Bozell moves from second place to first (566) over Cody Hawn (551) and Louis Miller (516).





The Techworks Trailers Street Stock leaderboard had Kyle VanSparrentak in a familiar position following qualifying—at the top with a 14.735 (91.619 MPH) lap speed. Ricky LaDuke (below) and Mike Gain won their respective 8-lap heat races.

In the 35-lap feature, Ricky LaDuke moved into the lead with 29 laps remaining. Kyle VanSparrentak hung with him and cut into LaDuke's lead but wasn't able to make the pass. Brandon Zachary, Kyle Ribble and Alex Sexton were all players in the race; Sexton getting around Ribble with 15 laps remaining and Zachary slipping to fifth. When the checkered flag waved it was Ricky LaDuke (below) with Kyle VanSparrentak in the runner-up position. Alex Sexton placed third followed by Kyle Ribble and Brandon Zachary. Blake Hybels led off the second half of the top ten followed by Mike Gain, Bobby Oxford, Gabe Sheppard and Kenny Head II. Alex Sexton (572) retains a slim margin over Kyle VanSparrentak (568) and Ricky LaDuke (545).

Matthew Elsey Jr. was the top qualifier in the O'Reilly Auto Parts Front Wheel Drives - Outlaws with a time of 14.998 (90.012 MPH). He

followed his fast time with a G-lap heat win. Charles Anderson Jr. drove his way into Victory Lane in Heat #2. Five laps into the 25-lap feature, Matt Elsey took the lead

with Matthew Elsey Jr. working his way quicky through the field. Elsey Jr. moved into the lead with about 10 laps remaining. With only five laps left, there was a three-car pile-up due a car dumping oil on the track; leader Elsey Jr. left the track under tow. Despite pressure from Cody Griffith on the restart, Matt Elsey prevailed and took the checkered flag. Griffith was the runner-up followed by Tyler May, Bryan Gates and Charles Anderson Jr. Amanda Weatherwax led off the second half of the order, followed by Matthew Elsey Jr. (-5), Brian Patton (-5), Case Roelofs (-6) and Tammy Breed (-6). With Dave Leonard's absence (blown engine last week), Matt Elsey and Matthew Elsey Jr. (545) are tied for the point lead with Bryan Gates moving into the third place (522).

Bentley Foote (middle right) won the 'B' feature with Bri Brady and Kaleb Dunn (3rd row left) also medaling in the 15-lap feature. Josh Forney was fourth followed by Brenden Keene, and Jacob Montgomery-Froelik.
