SEPTEMBER 20-22, 2024. DRIFTING 3-DAY EVENT.



Drifting starts at 1:00 PM each day, going until 10:00 PM on Friday and Saturday and 8 on Sunday. Music will run 4:00 – 11 PM on Friday and Saturday. There's a classic and modern car show Saturday from 3:00 - 7:00 PM and vendors will be onsite until 9:00 PM Friday-Saturday and Sunday through the afternoon. Ride-a-longs are possible with a pit pass!! Pit passes (for non-drivers) are \$20. Grandstand seats are \$5 for adults; 12 and under are free. Drifting events are rain or shine (spectators sit under the skyboxes to stay dry). Ticket and pit windows open at noon.


